

A NOTE FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

This Newsletter coming out means we are now halfway through 2019. I hope everyone is having a great year. The renovation of the credit union lobby is almost complete. We are completing some signage updates and cleaning up some landscaping issues and we will be finished. If you have not seen the new look, we invite you to stop in and see the updated facility. We are very proud of how it looks and we think you will like it too.

I want to forward some information to you on **ways to improve your credit score**. The most important aspect of increasing and maintaining a high credit score is to make all of your loan payments on time. Another key component of a high credit score is your *"Credit Utilization Rate". This compares your credit limit on credit cards (or your Kwik Cash loan) to the balance you carry on your statement. According to John Ulzheimer, credit expert, and former employee of FICO and Experian, "The higher that ratio, the fewer points you're going to earn in that category and your scores are absolutely going to suffer". He says "In FICO's systems, less than 10% utilization is the optimal target".

Please do your best to use only a small portion of your credit limit, or make it a goal to reduce your balance on credit cards so your credit score may increase over time.
